1. Pr. Ferror Hory, former prime minister of Humany, presently resident in the United States, and a covert associate of 100 is President of Perminder, a Swiss corporation with principal collices in Romand representatives in various parts of the world. The karld Treats Center, in which keep is also interested is associated with Ferninder. Brochures describing these organizations are attached.

- 2. Nacy has seized a representative of IOD if CIA would be interested in:
 - a) Placing en American businessmen on the Ecord of Ferminden.
 - b) Placing a CIA egent catthe stoff of Permindex.
 - e) Purchasing come chares in Ferminder through the chove representative on the Board in order to have a voice in the management of it. (Regy embeddees that the firm is well financed and that this is not a pitch for funds).
- 3. The advantages which in Rigg's judgment Permindex offers to CIA include opportunity to develop information on and centests in rang developing countries of Asia and Africa; cover; and the possibility of influencing the commiss of these countries to some extent. (Permindex is reported to have representatives reaching 52 countries, including the Bloo and several countries of Africa and Asia.
- 4. Permindex has just opened its offices and exhibit halls in Rome and expects to be in full operation in the spring of 1960.
- 5. Before pursuing this further, NOD would appreciate GH Staff's Judgment on the following:
 - a) Financial condition of Permindex and the World Trade Center. Dr. Heav says that Banca Bel Inhoro, Russ, Italy can supply full details on Euch matters.
 - b) Business potential of Permindex in the exhibit and international trade field; its competition; etc.

MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT: MARTELLO, Georges

- 1. In substance, the files contain the following information concerning Subject who was born Baruh MARDL on 11 December 1901, in the Budovins-transplyania region of East Cautral Europe, possibly in the village of Lechinta (47° 01° H 24° 21° K) in what is now Romania. In June or July 1942, Subject took up permanent residence in Switzerland, and has resided in Ceneva almost continuously since that time.
- 2. Generally described as being dishomest, unscrupulous and untrustvorthy, Subject has firstly established an unsavory business reputation
 in the transactions he has conducted over the last twenty years. In late
 1963 or early 1964, Subject spent a brief time, one source reported that it
 was two weeks, in a Swiss jail for illegal gold transactions. A weumly
 reliable source with wide knowledge of the European business community
 once refused to invest in a firm with which Subject was associated
 because he would have nothing to do with such a "Louche" sharacter.
- 3. Subject's one determinable loyalty is to his Jewish co-religionists, beginning in at loast September 1944, and perhaps starting a few months earlier, Subject supplied Jews trupped in Hungary with false documentation which enabled them to flow Hungary. Subject was able to provide this documentation by virtum of his position as El Selvadorian consular representative (his exact consular title was not made clear) in Geneva during the latter part of World War II. It has been reported that Subject assisted persons not in favor with the Hazi's to escape from Germany during World War II. The files indicate that Subject performed most of these services without remmeration, however, at least three unevaluated reports state or indicate that he sold the false documentation he was able to provide.
- 4. Subject has been frequently mentioned in cases of false documentation. In a report dated 16 November 1948, an official French source stated that one Rugene YESTCLEF had freedulantly obtained French passports for Subject, his wife Irene, and their son Enrique. Here questioned about these passports by the French authorities, Subject states that YESTCLEF had been entrusted with the task of procuring French sitisanship for Subject and his family, that YESTCLEF was to prove he had seemed French citisenship by giving Subject and his family French passports, and that Subject had never used the French passports YESTCLEF had given them because he suspected that they had been obtained irregularly. Subject's most recent known involvement with illegal documentation was reported in February 1952, when Subject was in serious trouble because an El Solvadorian passport he issued was found in the possession of an Italian Communist arrested for counterfeiting

by the police of Milan, Italy. This report further states that the "regular" MI Salvadorism Cansul is Geneva had recently received a bill for several MI Salvadorism samps and scale, which were "strictually deferred by Subject." The Commul had reportedly referred the metter to the Swiss police.

- 5. In 1951, two well-placed sources one of known reliability reported that Subject was already concepted with the Israeli Intelligence Service (IIS). One of these sources, who was of unknown reliability stated that the IIS had separated Subject from their service; no reason was given for this alleged separation. In October 1951 Subject was a partner in the "Depuis Pour is Commerce Suisse-Amerique Contrals" of Genera, which supplied cover employment for IIS agants. Subject's partner in the bank, Jack PADNA, was closely and actively associated with IIS work.
- 6. In a report dated 16 June 1946, a fairly reliable sectors reported that a Rumanian agent who was also a representative of the Tugoslav Intelligrace Service, was in contact with Subject and with and Josef NANIE, who is probably identical with Subject's brother. In 1944 and 1946, unsvaluated sources reported that Subject had been an agent of the Cestage.
- 7. Asserting to a report from the Paderal Bureau of Investigation, a "source of known reliability" had supplied the Bureau with a "List" (Black Back) used by efficials of the Yugoslav diplomatic and consular service. Pareons who applied for Yugoslav viess were checked against the list and, if their nesses appeared therein, it was necessary to seek prior approval of the Federal Secretarist of Foreign Affairs or the Federal Secretarist of Foreign Affairs or the Federal Secretarist of Internal Affairs. The hasis upon which the list was essential and the source of the information on the list were unknown to the Bureau's source. On roge ILL of the list, under the heading "Iareal", appeared an entry for MATTALLO-MARKE, George, (see of Bubject's aliass) bure 12/11/01, Leschnitts.
